



Overview

UNICO offers a number of training courses that provide your maintenance staff with the practical knowledge and skills necessary to comfortably and proficiently maintain UNICO products and systems. Our courses foster reliable and efficient troubleshooting techniques that reduce downtime, diminish frustration, and increase productivity.

Product Courses

Product courses provide hands-on training specific to each of UNICO's standard AC and DC drive products. Courses typically cover basic drive theory, layout and identification of components, installation, start-up, setup, interfaces, operation, routine maintenance, diagnostics, and troubleshooting. AC vector control and servo theory are also covered. Standard application software is used in these classes.

System Courses

System courses treat the integration of UNICO drives, controllers, and other components into a system. These courses are customized around your particular application. To the extent possible, your system is simulated in the classroom using the same drives and application software used in your plant. Students are taught to understand both hardware and software and how the two work together to control the rest of the machine. Applications range from simple, one- or two-drive systems such as feed-to-stops, infeed/outfeeds, flying cutoffs, and rotary cutoffs, to more complex systems such as in-press transfers, tension levers, and cut-to-length lines consisting of three or more drives.

Who Should Attend?

Courses are intended for technicians, maintenance and service engineers, and anyone else responsible for operating, maintaining, or servicing UNICO controls.

Courses vary in length as follows:

Product courses

2000 Series: 2 days

System courses

4-5 days

Additional days can be added upon request.

Location

Classes can be presented either at UNICO's training center, located in Franksville, Wisconsin, or at your facility for cost savings and convenience with larger groups. It is generally more economical for groups of three or less to attend at UNICO, although actual travel and living costs should be considered.
